

IRB:

Current question: Q1005_Does this project involve the use of identifiable human subjects via contact, data/records and/or survey, or the use of human tissue, serum, or other fluids?

New Proposed Question: Q1005_Does this project involve the use of identifiable private information or identifiable biospecimens from living individuals.

If yes:

a. Are JHU employees, students or postdoctoral fellows involved in direct contact with human subjects or will they access/use human subjects' identifiable private information or biospecimens?

If yes, triggers notification to PI that a submission to the JHSPH IRB is required.

b. Will a JHU subrecipient be involved with activities involving direct contact with human subjects or access/use of identifiable private information or biospecimens?

If yes, triggers notification to PI that a submission to the JHSPH IRB is required.

If yes, does the subrecipient have a Federal Wide Assurance (FWA)?

If yes, what is the subrecipient's FWA number?

Definitions:*

Identifiable private information is private information for which the identity of the subject is or may readily be ascertained by the investigator or associated with the information.

An identifiable biospecimen is a biospecimen for which the identity of the subject is or may readily be ascertained by the investigator or associated with the biospecimen.
