You do not need to be part of the group session beginning at 2:00pm; we just need you to attempt a log in for the load test. Thank you.

Below are some pointers to make participation easier:

• Group sessions are scheduled and shown on the <u>ORIS Calendar</u>, join them from the link provided there on each session day or click this <u>ZOOM</u> link. It is NOT mandatory to participate in group session testing; test whenever you can.

This week, group sessions begin at 2:00, pm.

• Information on logging in, how to test and how to report is on the <u>UAT page</u> at the <u>ORIS site</u>.

Click this **<u>FIBI link</u>** to go straight to the login page. **<u>Log in</u> with your JHED ID and password = polus123.** 

- We do ask specifically that you participate in the "LOAD TEST"; try to log into Fibi at least once at 2:00pm today. We want to measure the performance of the system when taxed by many users: will it work, will it slow, will it crash?
- There are resources at the **ORIS Learning** page to help you use Fibi: 1-2 minute videos, snapshots, guides, etc. Some of those resources continue to be edited and more are being created, however the basics are there and available for use.

• We encourage and hope you will try to test some every day; any amount of time devoted to working in the system is appreciated.

If we find bugs or other problems, POLUS will be actively working to remedy them as we go along. That is why it will be helpful to continue testing as much as you can through the two-week period.

This is a critical part of a successful launch of Fibi – and will ultimately help to determine a go-live date. Your participation in this round of UAT is very much appreciated; we hope you enjoy working in the new system!
