


Good morning, Functional Council Members!


As discussed yesterday, we're going to try a little something different for testing and communication this time around.

The FFC page has a calendar of FFC activities and links, as well as the link to the Forum. The link to the FFC page is **HERE**.




When you click on the forum, you can log in, set your own password and then access the posts we have there. The forum is organized with several sub-forums already, to see posts in those, just click on the blue text for the one you want to open.





Angel has posted a document called "Smartsheet" under the "Record your Testing Results." Smartsheet is an excel-like spreadsheet with all sorts of enhanced functions that will help us communicate and track testing activities.

She's created an example of how we'd like you to use the sheet in the first line. You will choose the items you want to test, line by line. If it passes/fails or you're unsure, enter your name in the appropriate column to show that it's been tested.



If you're not sure, or just want to say something, enter comments in the first column by clicking in the first column to open these options:
