Greetings, Fibi Users.

The JHU Research Administration Offices asked us to let you know that NSF will be strengthening login requirements for Research.gov.

Effective on **October 27, 2024**, external users must first complete a one-time Multifactor Authentication (MFA) enrollment process and use the MFA method to sign into Research.gov.

Additionally, users must:

1. only use their JHED email for login access; and
2. select one of the NSF phishing resistant methods for MFA (multi-factor authentication). MFA methods will be available for selection beginning October 27th.
